According to the source:

Ms. Kyung-Hui Song (경희송), a housewife and member of the Korean Socialist Women's Union, born on 27 September 1984 in Gangan-dong, Hyesan City, Ryanggang Province (DPRK), was allegedly abducted on 10 January 2010 from her home in from Hyesan City during a night raid along with other people related to her by agents of the Ministry of State Security, and detained thereafter. Ms. Song was allegedly pregnant at the time of her disappearance.

Ms. Song was last seen in detention in July 2010. She was also allegedly interrogated and subjected to torture including waterboarding while in detention.

In 2011, a person connected to Ms. Song was informed that she had been sentenced to five years in prison following a "secret" trial conducted at the Ministry of State Security. In 2013, a source at the Ministry of State Security allegedly revealed that Ms. Song was being detained at Hwasong kwanliso, political prison camp No. 16 in North Hamgyong Province. After Ms. Song finished serving her sentence, a person connected to her inquired with the Ministry of State Security as to the date of her release, but the request was dismissed by officials.

At the time of the present communication, the fate and whereabouts of Ms. Kyung-Hui Song remain unknown.

According to the source:

Ms. Hye-Hwa Jang (혜화장), a housewife and member of the Korean Socialist Women's Union, born on 8 April 1959 in Hyesan City, Ryanggang Province (DPRK) was allegedly detained on 10 January 2010 during a night raid along with other people from Hyesan City by agents of the Ministry of State Security.

Ms. Jang was held in detention ever since the night raid and she was allegedly tortured, including waterboarding. She was last seen in July 2010.

In 2011, a person connected to Ms. Jang was informed that she had been sentenced to five years in prison following a "secret" trial at the Ministry of State Security. In 2013, a source at the Ministry of State Security allegedly revealed that Ms. Jang was being detained at Hwasong (kwanliso), political prison camp No. 16 in North Hamgyong Province, Democratic People's Republic of Korea. After Ms. Jang finished serving her sentence, a person connected to her inquired with the Ministry of State Security as to the date of her release, but the request was dismissed by officials.

At the time of the present communication, the fate and whereabouts of Ms. Hye-Hwa Jang remain unknown.

According to the source:

Mr. Cheol-Min Seong (철민성), born on 29 August 1980 in Haesan-gu, Hamhung City, South Hamgyong Province (DPRK) was allegedly detained in March 2007 with a group of other persons while attempting to escape to South Korea by the People's Republic of China authorities in Sichuan Province.

Mr. Seong was detained in China until September 2007, when he was returned to the Democratic People's Republic of Korea. The Ministry of State Security of the DPRK then detained him in a detention center in Hyesan, where he was last seen around January-February 2008.

Mr. Seong was allegedly subjected to torture while in detention in Hyesan. He was then sentenced to a prison term following a "secret" trial at the Ministry of State Security. A source reported that the Ministry of State Security planned to transfer Mr. Seong to a political prison camp (kwanliso) in an undisclosed location.

At the time of the present communication, the fate and whereabouts of Mr. Cheol-Min Seong remain unknown.

According to the source:

Ms. Hye-Shin Paek (혜신 백), born on 1 February 1995 in Kangwon Province (DPRK) was allegedly abducted by agents of the DPRK in March 2007 in her residence in Minpo-dong 2-ban, Sinuiju City, North Pyongan Province. It is reported that State authorities confiscated Ms. Paek's residence and transferred her to a remote location within the DPRK, along with another family member, without adequate shelter or access to food, in retaliation for her family relationship with a DPRK defector.

At the time of the present communication, the fate and whereabouts of Ms. Ms. Hye-Shin Paek remain unknown.
